

(1) Mud Flap Driver Side




(1) Mud Flap Passenger Side










1: Remove the factory hardware on the fender as shown. Discard.




2-1: Loosely install hardware as shown.


2-2: Secure hardware installed in step 2-1 as shown.


3-1: Loosely install hardware as shown.

4-1: While holding the threaded clip from behind, install hardware through hole #2 and into clip as shown in Step 4-2



4-2: Loosely install hardware from step 4-1 into the threaded clip as shown.





5-1: Loosely install hardware as shown.


6-1: Loosely install hardware as shown and secure from behind with hardware shown in Step 6-2
